I suggested a fifteen panel Hanging Wall Unit for History to be hung in the History Section of the Library in the back of the The Harbor Clubhouse. Lights Cooperative Board approved the purchasing of the Unit in late 2023 but purchased another fifteen panels to the unit. The extra panels were paid for by donations from Cassie Cowan and Tom Kelly.
